I've participated in Walleye tournaments across the Midwest for years, including In-Fisherman Professional Walleye Trail, Walleye Circuit Masters, with top 10 finishes, along with Walleye Circuit Team Masters of the Year honors. Three-time World Cup qualifier Walleye. I also write a monthly column in the Mid West Outdoors Magazine Wisconsin section pertaining to Castle Rock Lake Lake in Wisconsin inset section, and I have been invited to present workshops at various fishing clubs, sports shows and retail outlets. My fishing season is on Castle Rock and Lake Petenwell, and the adjacent river starts in March and passes through the ice. It is widely used for many recreational activities such as boating, fishing, swimming, hunting and canoeing/kayaking. The flow provides many opportunities for onshore anglers in various locations. Petenwell Flowage has an annual musket tournament founded by Todd Forcier and has hosted rough fish archery tournaments. The stumps, submerged wood and shallow water make parts of the current difficult to navigate. Almost the entire coastline is open to the public, with few exceptions. Petenwell Flowage is widely known for exciting spring walleye runs, with a good amount of bass, crappie, musk and northern pike also available. Interactive Lake Map For more detailed map of the lake and up to a minute fishing reports contact the Petenwell Flowage Waterway page at Fishidy. The edges of the canal should be caught in winter. At the beginning of winter, focus on the shallow upper edge of the canal with tips with 3-5-inch sheen. As winter continues, the focus is on the base of drop-offs. Deep wood along the edges of the canal will keep the walleye in winter. Moving water and springs can often create unsafe ice conditions: caution is recommended. Barnum Bay is a good location to look for a winter crappie. Small jigs and small hooks are tipped with minnows to produce consistent catches. Jigging style bait will also work, but not as consistently as live bait. The best opportunity to catch a perch during late ice. Deep wooden structures and muddy areas of the bottom produce the best catches of perch. Lindy ice jigs are tipped with wax worms and various jigging spoons work well. Bluegill and crappie can be taken from shallow water by early ice anglers on Skibba Slough. The Devils elbow consistently produces walleye and crappie throughout the season. The best action usually occurs in spring and late autumn, but some fish can be caught in the early ice period. Keep in mind that sources and currents in this area can create unsafe ice conditions. South of Twin Lakes, the steep drop-off along the east coast has plenty of walleye throughout the season. Crappie and walleye can be caught under the ice while fishing landing and 15 feet deep. Winter anglers concentrate on a walleye at 10 to 25 feet deep east of Longview Point. Golden shining about 3 to 4 Suspended below the tip of the window will produce fish. My name is John Oens and I have been guiding and fishing at Petenwell and Castlerock Flowages and their tributaries for over 30 years. I primarily guide the Wisconsin River system from below castlerock Dam north over the Nekoosa Dam. Through a conversation with my clients, I learned that many guides just want to be paid to go fishing. Many guides also brief their clients on time and kick them out of the boat quickly so they can load the next group during the day. That's not the case with me. Aside from keeping you on the fish, my main focus is to make sure you have fun. This means that I deal with hooked baits, broken lines and heavy anchors while you fish. During the day I will share the knowledge that I have acquired about the pond we fish. I promote catch and release, however I also love eating certain kinds of fish. I'll be happy to clean and pack your catch days if you decide to keep any of your fish. In case you fish trophy proportions it is your decision to either keep the fish to be set or photographed and release it to fight another day, after I take the length and girth measurements for possible attaching the replica. For your safety, I am a certified American Heart Association Basic Life Support Instructor certified in the use of PPC, AED and Basic First Aid. This means that I am familiar with the identification and provision of emergency care for all types of emergency medical care. With that included I provide all fishing and safety equipment including rods, baits, baits and gear. I currently work on two boats. One is a wide G-3 deep-V powered by a 4-tactical 75 hp Yamaha. Another 16-foot Alumacraft flatbottom powered by 25 hp Johnson, which I use to access shallow ponds that many guides dismiss. What to bring with you; rain equipment, warm clothes, polarized sunglasses, personal medicines, personal fishing gear, food and drinks. You must have a current Wisconsin fishing license. Responsible use of tobacco and alcohol is welcome on my boat (except for me). Prices you will find my rates to be lower than those of my competitors at \$225 to two anglers for eight hours of fishing. Each additional angler is \$50 per angler.
